## SAFETY – POLICY AND PRACTICE

Staff/Parents Pack

Here at Humpty Dumpty Pre-school, the safety of young children is of paramount importance. In order to ensure the safety of both children and adults, the Pre-school will ensure that:-

- 1. All children are supervised by adults at all times and will always be within sight of an adult.
- 2. Adults do not walk about with hot drinks or place hot drinks within reach of the children.
- 3. A book is available at all times for the reporting of any accident/incident that may occur.
- 4. Fire drills are held once every ½ term.
- 5. A register of both children and adults is completed every morning, adding any late arrivals as they come.
- 6. A visitor's book is completed for anyone who arrives at the pre-school to look around or for an appointment.
- 7. Regular safety monitoring will include checking the accident and incident book.
- 8. A risk assessment must be done every ½ term.
- 9. All adults are aware of the systems in operation for children's arrivals and departures and an adult will be at the hall door at all times during these times.
- 10. There is no smoking anywhere on the premises.
- 11. A correctly stocked first aid box is available at all times.
- 12. Children will leave the group only with an authorized adult who has been police checked.
- 13. Fire extinguishers are checked annually, and all staff know how to use them.
- 14. Safety checks on premises, both indoors and outdoors, are made before every session.
- 15. Whenever children are on the premises at least two adults are present at all times.
- 16. The main entrance to the building must be locked at all times and the key kept close near an adult at all times.
- 17. Large equipment is erected with care and checked regularly.

- 18. On all outings, the adult to child ratio will be at least one adult to two children.
- 19. All equipment is checked regularly and any dangerous/broken items repaired/discarded.
- 20. If a small group goes out, there will be sufficient adults to maintain appropriate ratios for staff and children remaining on the premises.
- 21. All fire doors are never obstructed.
- 22. Equipment offered to the children is developmentally appropriate, recognizing that materials suitable for an older child may pose a risk to younger/less mature children.
- 23. Fires/heaters electric points/wires and leads are adequately guarded.
- 24. All dangerous materials, including medicines and cleaning materials, are stored out of reach of all children.
- 25. The premises are always checked before locking up for the day/session.
- 26. Children do not have unsupervised access to the kitchens cookers or any cupboards storing hazardous materials including matches.
